This manual is intended to help the readers understand the AccountMate 7 for SQL/Express System Manager module Database Design. It is organized by chapters which detail each back end tables, front end tables, remote view, stored procedure and data relationship under the System Manager module.

The ***E-R Diagram*** chapter shows the data relationships of tables used in the System Manager Module.

The ***Back end Table*** chapter lists the back end tables used by the System Manager Module to access the back end company database.

The ***Front end Table*** chapter lists the front end tables used by the System Manager Module.

The ***Remote Views*** chapter lists the remote views used by the System Manager Module to access the back end company database.

The ***Data Integrity*** chapter lists the rules governing data consistency, specifically the relationships between the primary keys and foreign keys of different tables. This chapter will assist you to identify how records are inserted, updated, or deleted in related tables.

The ***Stored Procedures*** chapter lists the back end stored procedures used in the System Manager module. It also includes a list of the VFP forms from where each stored procedure is called.
