AM 11.2 for SQL/Express Build Released March 12th

Last Thursday, **AccountMate 11.2 for SQL/Express** was available for your AccountMate Solution Provider to **download** your product update if you are on a current Maintenance Plan.

The primary feature enhancements are:

- No longer a separate download, **Spanish and French languages** are made available as an option from within AccountMate 11.2. This is handy for users who want to read and record transactions in Spanish or French languages; thereby giving the flexibility of having specific users or even the entire company use Spanish, French, or both languages.
- AccountMate 11.2 allows you to **assign user access rights** rather than require users to enter the Supervisor password like in the previous versions in order to access the following functions: Error Log Reviewer, Fiscal Period Table Setup, Data Manager, and Company Access Lock. Though a Supervisor password is no longer required, data security is strengthened by restricting access to sensitive information only to authorized users.
- New function keys and hotkeys allow for registered users to perform tasks more quickly than using a mouse or other input devices.
- Supports the latest SQL Server version 2019.
- Payroll Enhancements have been added to:
 - Separately track the Adjusted and Converted Paid Leave Hours from the YTD Accumulated and YTD Used Paid Leave Hours
 - Compliance to the National Payment Corporation's recent requirements for Electronic Payment Files
 - Allow import of tips when importing timecard data that contain Earning Hour Columns Option to include tips when validating Employee Minimum Wage
- Copying of Line Items from Historical Work Orders allows for more flexibility when creating new work orders by being able to copy information from existing ones.

2020 Payroll Tax Changes

The 2020 Payroll Tax information and changes (by State and Federal) have become available. As we learn about any Federal and/or State tax changes, you will find them noted on our [website](#).

So far the only change that has occurred since we sent out the last UserLine in February is for the State of Maryland for their Standard Deduction which released 2/28/20.

Checking for New Payroll Tax Updates?

For all our clients running AccountMate's Payroll module, most likely your AccountMate Solution Provider has installed the 2020 updates. But don't forget that tax updates happen all year long at the federal and state levels. Make it a habit to check for changes to your licensed states, at least quarterly.

Haven't done that before? Don't worry. The whole process should take five minutes or less. Try it right now for practice:

First check what version you currently have installed. Hit **<Help><About AccountMate>** and look on **Payroll** tab for the **Payroll Tax Subscription Version #**.

Look at the latest release date. If your current version is something earlier than the latest version, then download the new version—review the steps below. It's easy to install yourself for free, but if you prefer, your Solution Provider would be glad to connect to your system and install it for you for a small charge; it won't take long and no need for you to hesitate to ask them.

Download tax updates:

1. All other users need to be out of the system.
2. Go to **<Utilities><Check for Payroll Subscription Updates>**, where you may be prompted for the Supervisor password.
3. Depending on the security settings of your network, the update will either install completely automatically—or it will just download the file prsubam.exe to the root directory of your AccountMate installation and you need to then execute it with a **<right click><run as administrator>**.
4. If you have "local installations" of the AccountMate executable (meaning your AccountMate shortcut is pointing to C:\ rather than a server drive), then this will need to be run from all desktop PCs that use the Payroll module.

Then be sure to then check **<Help><About AccountMate>** again to confirm you're seeing the new version number as your current version.

NOTE: You might want to schedule a recurring alert in your calendar to check for new updates at least once per quarter.
