AccountMate 12.1 for SQL/Express Upcoming Release

In later January 2021 we plan to release our upcoming AccountMate SQL and Express version: AccountMate 12.1 for SQL and Express.

Some of the higher visibility enhancements are:

New TaxJar Integration Module - The new TaxJar Integration module provides sales

tax automation where correct tax rates are determined based on your Nexus state and each state's Economic Nexus Laws, your customer's tax exemption type, their shipping address, and the type of products included in an order. Some products could be either exempted from sales tax or taxed at a reduced rate in different tax jurisdictions. With this module, AccountMate provides complete flexibility in allowing users to decide whether they want to take the responsibility of maintaining the tax rates and choosing the sales tax code for each transaction or to allow TaxJar to determine the correct tax rate.

Enhancement Information & Recorded Webinar: New IRS 1099 Reporting and an AccountMate Reporting Enhancement

A challenge has come up for updating systems to address the **new IRS 1099 reporting requirements** that split non-employee compensations out of the 1099-MISC to a new 1099-NEC form. AccountMate is providing **an AP 1099 Reporting Enhancement** at no charge to our Registered Users on Lifecycle or Standard Maintenance. This enhancement can be installed by your AccountMate Solution Provider and is available for the AccountMate Accounts Payable (AP) module.

Please also consult with your tax accountant and refer to the IRS website for legal details. The overview is that the 1099-MISC form has been reformatted and retains reporting

for rents (box 1), royalties (box 2), prizes and other income payments (box 3), fishing boat proceeds (box 5), medical and health care payments (box 6), crop insurance proceeds (box 9), payments to an attorney (box 10), section 409A deferrals (box 12) and nonqualified deferred compensation (box14); while the **brand new 1099-NEC form must be used for "Non-Employee Compensation,"** (previously reported on the 1099-MISC form box 7). Importantly, IRS regulations specify the **forms must be provided to the recipients by January 31, 2021** and **penalties are steep!**

If any of you have missed the information that was presented earlier this month, be sure to watch the on-demand recorded **Generating AP 1099-MISC and 1099-NEC in AccountMate webinar**. Review this at your convenience but **DEFINITELY now before the January 31st deadline**. The content of the webinar makes the listener aware of the important changes to the AP Form 1099-MISC and be familiar with the new Form 1099-NEC. By watching this webinar, you will learn how to generate, print, or e-file these reports in AccountMate.

Beginning of Year Activities

We would recommend you consider a few practical "beginning of the year" activities:

- Lock your January 2020 fiscal period: Whether you have closed the fiscal year or not, now is the time check that you don't make a typo mistake for the year in a transaction and accidently post it 12 months in history!
- Make a backup of your live company: You will want detailed listings to validate
 your General Ledger -- whether that's an AR or AP Aging report or a Warehouse
 Quantity Listing. And while AccountMate provides "as of" reports for validating many
 of the Balance Sheet accounts, it could happen that someone back dates a
 transaction which you really didn't want backdated. If that happens, it's nearly
 impossible to create the validating report
- Set your Accounts Payable 1099 Year: When you access the reports in the Accounts Payable (AP) module for print 1099 reports and forms, they will reference "Current 1099 Year" and "Prior 1099 Year. These don't specifically say what year. To set that, hit <Housekeeping><AP Module Setup> and then access the "1099 Setup" tab to set the Current Year in the combo-box at the top. The combo-box only shows three years at a time, so if you are more than a year back, then you'll need to set it to the latest year you can, hit <OK> at the bottom and then go back in again to advance it another year.

Hopefully, these 'helpful hints' might save you some time and aggravation.

A Favorite "Hint": Photocopy Your Wallet Content

What?! Photocopy your wallet contents may sound too trite – but if you've ever been caught in a situation where your wallet is lost or misplaced, this might actually be a helpful precaution. Take five minutes to photocopy the contents of all of the cards in your wallet (personal and business). Line them face down on the copier (first on the front side; then on the back side) and hit the copy button.

This quick project could save you both time and anguish if your wallet is lost or stolen – or even a chance to review what you are carrying around and what cards might be expired.

The **2021 Payroll Tax Subscription program** supports the printing of the following tax forms, which is the same as previous years except for the addition of Form 1099-NEC:

 - 2 up on plain paper only for federal filing Items # 5207, 5222
 - 4 up perforated blank paper for the Employer, Employee, and State copies Items # 5209, 5221 (Note: The Employee copy can have the instructions printed at the back, but it is not required.)
- W-3 (on plain paper only) for federal filing
- 1099-MISC
 - 2 up on RED pre-printed form for federal filing Item # 5110
 - 4 up perforated blank paper for the Payer, Recipient, and State copies Item # 5221 (Note: The Recipient copy can have the instructions printed at the back, but it is not required.)
 - 1096 (on RED pre-printed form) for federal filing Item # 5100
- 1099-NEC (new)
 - 2 up on RED pre-printed form for federal filing Item # NEC511
 - 4 up perforated blank paper for the Payer, Recipient, and State copies Item # NEC610 (Note: The Recipient copy can have the instructions printed at the back, but it is not required.)
 - 1096 (on RED pre-printed form) for federal filing Item # 5100

Technical Note: Performing Period-End Closing in a Stand-Alone Sales Order and Purchase Order Module

Period-End Closing plays an important role in AccountMate. It is through this function that data is permanently transferred from the subsidiary modules to General Ledger. This week, we publish Article #1132: Performing Period-End Closing in a Stand-Alone Sales
Order and Purchase Order Module. This Technical Note discusses the effects that Period-End Closing in a stand-alone Sales Order and/or Purchase Order module has on transaction records, General Ledger entries, and relevant SO and PO tables.

Q: I encountered the error, "Error opening Company.asd", after hitting the Preview button in the **Print/E-File 1099** function. How do I resolve this?

A: This error occurs if you have changed the company Federal ID after you have generated 1099 reports using a different Federal ID. To resolve this issue, perform the following:

- 1. Using Windows Explorer, go to the AccountMate CommonFiles directory if you are using AccountMate for SQL and Express. If you are using AccountMate for LAN, then go to the AccountMate program files directory.
- 2. Then, go to the **Data\AP** subfolder.
- 3. Find the Company ID of the company where you encountered the error.
- 4. Rename or create a backup of the Company ID folder.
- 5. Delete the folder.
- 6. Launch AccountMate to re-create the files with the updated information.

Q: The **Print 1099 Form** function is not updated to reflect the changes in the 2020 Form 1099-MISC? Why?

A: The Print 1099 Form function has an outdated form. Do not use this function to print

2020 Form 1099-MISC. You must use the **Print/E-File 1099** function to print and E-File Form 1099-MISC. This function is available when the **AP 1099 Reporting Program Enhancement** is installed. This function replaces the **Print 1099 Form** and the **1099 Electronic Filing** functions. Printing and E-Filing Form 1099-NEC is also available in this new function.

Q: I noticed that Form 1099-MISC is no longer available in the Tax Forms function. Why?

A: The **Payroll** module only supports the **nonemployee compensation (NEC)** 1099 type. Starting Tax Year 2020, nonemployee compensation must be reported using Form 1099-NEC, which is available in **Tax Forms**.

Tech Support Tips (Common Errors During Period-End Closing)

Versions: AM11 for SQL and Express

AM10 for SQL, Express, and LAN AM9 for SQL, Express, and LAN

AM8 for LAN

Module: All Modules

Error: Scheduled period end-closing is in progress. Do you want to continue accessing the company?

Cause: Either period-end/fiscal year-end closing is still in progress or it failed due to errors causing AccountMate to lock the functions.

Solution: Starting in AccountMate 10.2 for SQL/Express, you can either:

- Click Yes; then, access the Data Manager function in the Utilities menu and choose the Release Year/Period-End Closing or Transfer Lock option.
- Click No; then, access from the Select Company window another company that is not locked.

For versions lower than AccountMate 10.2 for SQL/Express, there is a variation in the message and the following are the available options:

- Click OK; then, access from the Select Company window another company that is not locked.
- Set GLBSYS.lactive to zero to access the company; then, access the Data Manager function in the Utilities menu and release the Period-End Closing Lock for the company that has been locked.

Error: Account ID does not exist/Invalid Account ID.

Cause: The Account Balances (GLABAL) table contains a GL Account ID (cAcctID) that does not exist in the Chart of Accounts Maintenance table (GLACCT).

Solution: Verify that the **GLABAL** ➤ **cAcctID** field is not empty and that all the GL Account IDs assigned to the records in **GLABAL** exist in **GLACCT**. If these GL Account IDs do not exist in **GLACCT** yet valid, add them back using the **Chart of Accounts Maintenance** function.
