Reminder: Employee Retention Tax Credit

The Employee Retention Tax Credit (ERTC) is a valuable tax break that was extended and modified by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Originally, the ERTC applied to wages paid after March 12, 2020, and before Jan. 1, 2021. Congress later modified and extended the ERTC to apply to wages paid before July 1, 2021. The ARPA again extended and modified the ERTC to apply to wages paid after June 30, 2021, and before Jan. 1, 2022. The maximum ERTC available is generally \$7,000 per employee per calendar quarter or \$28,000 per employee in 2021. Other modifications have also been made that may be beneficial to your business.

This is part of last year's payroll tax update and will continue this year. It does not affect the payroll calculation other than AccountMate provided a field for employer to claim the ERTC from tax deposit.

Next Year: AM 9.x for SQL/Express No Longer Supported After March 2022 – Time to upgrade

We always want to remind you of events that can assist you to plan ahead. One that comes to mind is that AccountMate 9.x for SQL/Express will no longer be supported after March although current tax subscriptions will be honored through the end of 2022 (until Dec 31, 2022).

If your company happens to be running AccountMate 9.x for SQL/Express, you and your AccountMate Solution Provider might want to begin talking about your upgrade options.

IRS Section 179 Enables Full Purchase Price of Software & Equipment Through 2021

You still have a month to think about buying software – including more AccountMate modules and our vertical solution add-on software solutions – and equipment before December 31, 2021 to take advantage of some of what the Internal Revenue Section 179 tax deduction has to offer.

The Section 179 tax code allows businesses to be credited the full purchase price of the equipment or software (up to \$1,050,000) all at once without having to account for depreciation.

Technical Note: How to Allocate Inventory Related Costs Using the Landed Cost Feature

When you purchase goods, you may incur costs including freight charges, handling costs, import duties, and other incidental costs necessary for the shipment of the goods. These inventory-related costs may be recorded either directly to expense/Cost of Goods Sold or added to the received goods purchase costs.

AccountMate implements a Landed Cost feature that allows you to use the accrual method to record the landed costs and to increase the inventory cost. This feature also provides several options to allocate these costs to the received goods in each PO receipt transaction. This Article # 1216: How to Allocate Inventory Related Costs Using the Landed Costs Feature. provides a comprehensive discussion on how to record the accrual and allocation of landed cost using the Accrue Landed Cost function in the Purchase Order (PO) module. This document also discusses the procedures for recording the accrued landed cost reversal using the AP Invoice Transactions function in the Accounts Payable (AP) module.

Feature Focus Tips (AM12.2 Enhancement - Office 365)

Versions: AM12 for SQL and Express (MS1202)

Modules: SM

TIP: AccountMate 12.2 for SQL and Express supports **Office 365** for outbound e-mails. You can now choose between **Exchange** or **Office 365**. The Exchange option is available only if Microsoft Outlook is installed.

You can configure per company the **Outbound E-mail** type to use in the AccountMate Administrator \triangleright Company Setup \triangleright Add/Edit Company \triangleright Outbound E-mail area.

Versions: AM12 for SQL and Express (MS1202)

Modules: SM

TIP: The **Mail Credentials** tab in **Workstation Setup** will be enabled if you chose to use **Office 355** for your company's outbound e-mails. Enter in this tab the username and password for your Office 365 account. AccountMate will then verify whether the credentials you entered are correct.

Versions: AM12 for SQL and Express (MS1202)

Modules: SM

TIP: Click the Test E-mail Connection button in the Workstation Setup ➤ Mail Credentials tab to verify whether you have entered the correct username and password. If the test connection was successful, then AccountMate will display the message, "Test connection successful. A test e-mail has been sent." Check your mailbox for the e-mail; the e-mail has the subject "Test E-mail" with no content. The sender and receiver are the same, which is your Office 365 e-mail address. If the credentials are not valid or incorrect, then AccountMate will display the message, "Test connection failed. Please re-enter your correct username and/or password."

Q: What is the purpose of the **Account #** and **Bank Routing #** in the **AP Deduction Setup** window?

A: The Account # and Bank Routing # in the AP Deduction Setup window are entered for information purposes if you link Payroll deductions to an AP vendor. The information will be displayed in the Deduction Liability Report, which serves as a reference when posting AP invoices for the remittance of employee deductions. The availability of the vendor's Account # and Bank Routing # in the report will tell you that the vendor may be paid via electronic payment. With the information handy, it will be easier to set up the vendor for electronic payment. The Account # and Bank Routing # fields are not required fields; you may leave these fields empty.

Q: How does AccountMate update the **Last Received Cost** and **Date** in the **Inventory Maintenance** ➤ **Settings (1)** tab?

A: The Last Received Cost and Date in Inventory Maintenance ➤ Settings (1) tab is updated when you record a receipt of the inventory item using the Receive Goods function; the last received cost is from the Unit Cost field and the date is from the Receive Date field. If you cancel the received goods with the latest Receive Date, the Last Received Cost and Date displayed in the inventory record remain the same. AccountMate will update the information the next time you record a receipt for the item with the same or later Receive Date.

• **Note**: In AccountMate for LAN, the Last Received Cost and Date fields are in the **Inventory Maintenance** ➤ **Settings** tab.
